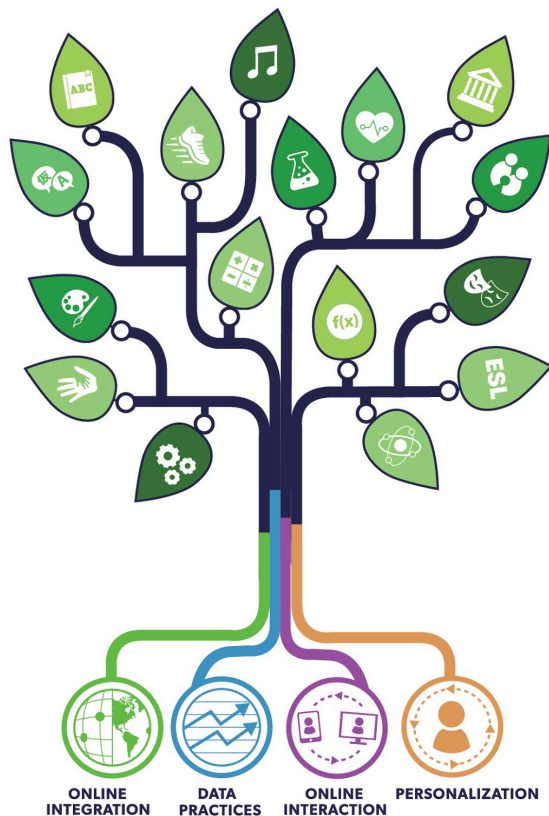


# English Language Arts (ELA): Intro to Blended Teaching

## 4.1 Purpose
