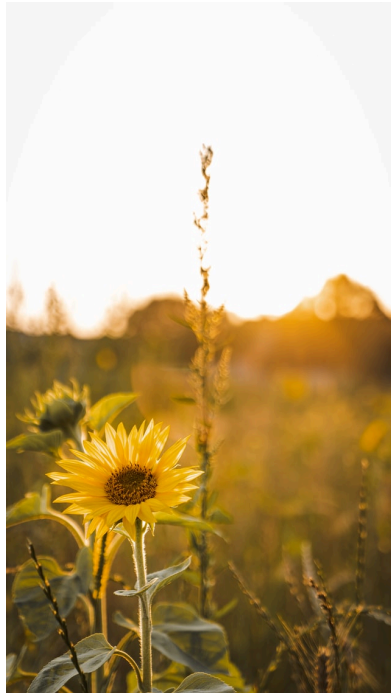


Self-Regulation
