Teachers can recognize the myths surrounding the education of English Learners and counteract the myths with positive behaviors and attitudes.

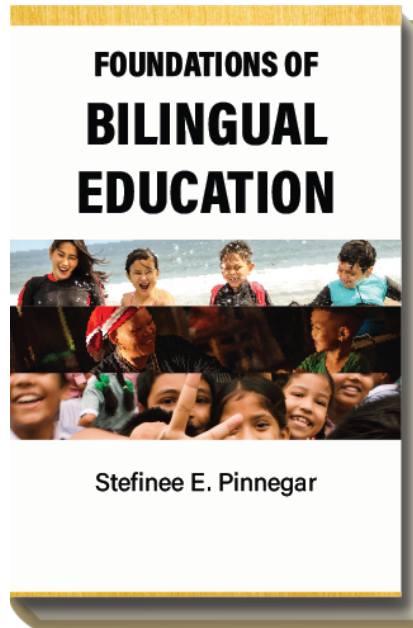
Student Position
