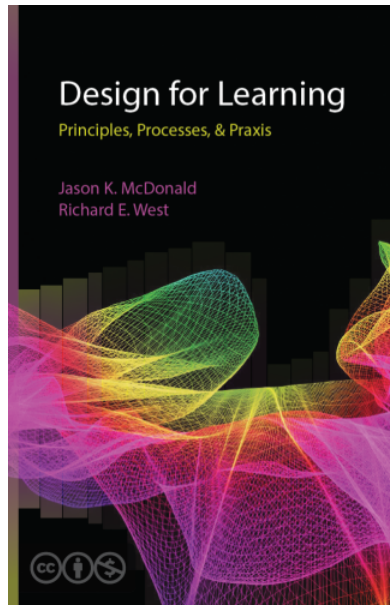


Evaluating
