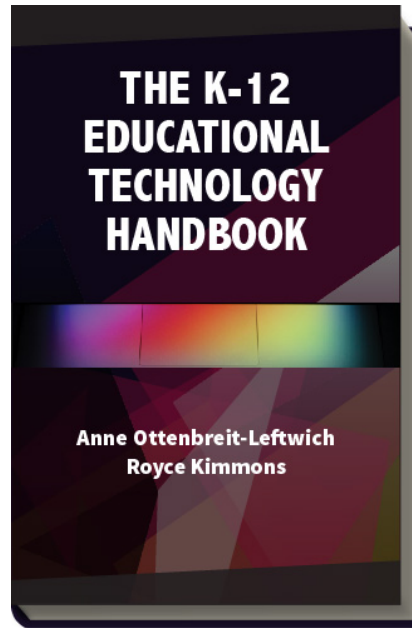


Legal, Ethical, and Socially-Responsible Use
