Background

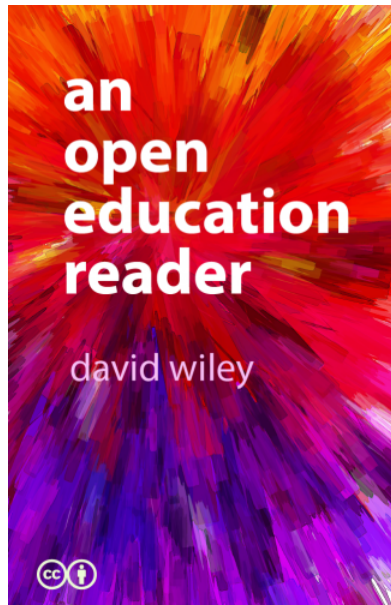
Two MIT OCW videos (to this point) have been in the top 10 on Youtube - they are advanced engineering and math courses.
