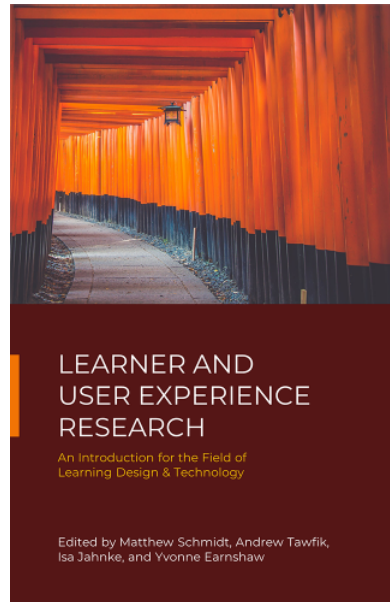


LX Design-in-Use
